Any shooter who is misclassed or incorrectly entered/not entered in an event and not corrected before shooting will forfeit all Medals and Option monies for that event. The class will be corrected, but no further action will be taken.

IT IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE SHOOTER
TO VERIFY ALL ENTRY INFORMATION BEFORE
LEAVING THE REGISTRATION AREA.

Eligibility and Classification

- 1. This is a closed event. All participants must be current members of NSSA and be a resident within Tennessee, verified from the member's NSSA record and per Rule II-C-3.
- Shooters must present their classification/shoot record card with all scores shot before the current date properly and legibly recorded.
- 3. Teams are not required to shoot shoulder-to-shoulder.
- A participant's HOA class will not be lower than his or her lowest gun class.

Registration

- 1. Participants are highly encouraged to pre-register.
- Shooters participating in fewer than the entire 4-gun Program will be scheduled as near to the requested times as possible but must be accommodated at the convenience of the shoot management by necessity.
- 3. Eligibility for AAA class will be determined based on average at the last classification or reclassification of the appropriate gauge.
- 4. Entry for HOA event requires registration and payment of entry fees for all involved events before firing in the first gauge of the event the shooter wishes to enter.
- There will be no refunds for withdrawal, except in the case of extreme emergencies. There will be no refunds for withdrawal or cancellation due to adverse weather conditions.
- Anyone entering an event for which they are not eligible will not be given a refund if the error is not discovered until after they have shot the event.

Shooting Procedures

- Current NSSA rules will be used throughout the tournament unless otherwise stated in the program or posted in the registration area.
- 2. All events will be shot 100 targets on a field using the flight system. Each flight will have one and a half hours to shoot 100 targets. Each flight will start on time, and in the case of a breakdown, slow squad, etc., shoot management reserves the right to move the squad to a practice field. Any squad or shooter not ready when called will be placed on a space-available basis. If space is not available, the squad or shooters will not be able to shoot the event. No refunds will be issued in these cases.
- 3. All changes to a squad lineup must be made at registration before shooting the event. Any changes made on the field without the permission of shoot management will result in the disqualification of those participants for that event.
- 4. Shooters will provide their proof shells.

Shoot-offs and Ties

- Champions and Class 1st will shoot off ties. All other awards will be by long run. NSSA rules will be in effect. No alcohol before or during shooting.
- Management reserves the right to refuse entry or cause the withdrawal of any contestant whose conduct in the opinion of shoot management is unsportsmanlike or whose participation is in any way detrimental to the best interests of the shoot.
- 3. Management reserves the right to alter or change the program without recourse or protest as conditions
- Shooters and spectators are aware of the danger associated with this sport. Risk of accident or property loss is assumed by all individuals present on the grounds.
- 5. Eye and ear protection are mandatory for all personnel on or near the fields
- Purse checks will be mailed. All other awards not picked up at the shoot will become the property of TSSA.

Other Information

- 1. All payouts will be mailed.
- 2. Shoot management reserves the right to change, cancel, or postpone any part of the program.

- Shoot management reserves the right to refuse any entry or cause the withdrawal of any participant who annoys, endangers, or interferes with the harmony of the shoot.
- 4. Spectators and contestants assume all risks resulting from accidents or loss of property occurring on host gun club properties.
